The new dues schedule is based on newsroom Full-Time Equivalent (FTEs) — i.e., the total number of 40-hour workweeks spent working in the editorial department of each member news organization. FTE is a unit indicating the workload of an employee in terms of a 40-hour workweek.

For instance, an employee who works in the newsroom 20 hours per week is considered 1/2 of an FTE, and two 20-hour per week newsroom employees add up to one newsroom FTE.

Or a full-time employee who works half their time in the newsroom and the other half working on the business is considered one FTE for the company but only 1/2 of a “newsroom FTE.”

Full-time equivalents are often used to measure a worker’s involvement in a project, or to track costs in an organization.
